

Advent is a Latin word that means "coming" or "arrival." Advent begins four Sundays before Christmas Day on the Church calendar and culminates on Christmas Eve. It is a season full of hope, expectation, and longing.

Christians have observed Advent as a time to remember Jesus's first Advent (His coming as a baby born in Bethlehem) and anticipate His second Advent (His triumphant future return). Christmas trees will need to be discarded in January. Much JOY will be found for those who plant themselves securely to Jesus! Peace and love fam!






Strength! Courage! Looking to the right and left can misguide or misinform us. Lets fix our gaze toward JESUS! Peace and love fam!

Forgive as the Lord forgave you. And over all these virtues put on love, which binds them all together in perfect unity. Let the peace of Christ rule in your hearts, since as members of one body you were called to peace. And be thankful. Let the message of Christ dwell among you richly as you teach and admonish one another with all wisdom through psalms, hymns, and songs from the Spirit, singing to God with gratitude in your hearts. And whatever you do, whether in word or deed, do it all in the name of the Lord Jesus, giving thanks to God the Father through him. (Colossians 3:12-17)

Imitate God, therefore, in everything you do, because you are his dear children. Live a life filled with love, following the example of Christ. He loved us and offered himself as a sacrifice for us, a pleasing aroma to God. (Ephesians 5:1-2)

You will keep in perfect peace all who trust in you, all whose thoughts are fixed on you! Trust in the Lord always, for the Lord God is the eternal Rock. (Isaiah 26:3-4)

You and I have enough head space where trusting God and resting in His peace can fill. Peace and love fam!



Save me, O God, for the waters have come up to my neck. I sink in the miry depths, where there is no foothold. I have come into the deep waters; the floods engulf me. I am worn out calling for help; my throat is parched. My eyes fail, looking for my God. (Psalms 69:1-3)

The Lord hears his people when they call to him for help. He rescues them from all their troubles. The Lord is close to the brokenhearted; he rescues those whose spirits are crushed. The righteous person faces many troubles, but the Lord comes to the rescue each time. For the Lord protects the bones of the righteous; not one of them is broken! (Psalms 34:17-20)
